Time: Setup at 8:30am, Shooting Starts 9:00am
(shotgun range requested from 0800 to 1300)

Cost: \$20 per shooter

Location: Calverton Range located at 31 Mill River Road, Calverton, NY 11993

Firearm: Any NY legal shotgun (pump, break-open, semi-automatic)

Caliber: 12 gauge, 20 gauge, .410 (#7-1/2, #8 or #9 shot as per club rules)

Course of Fire:

3 stages, 15 clay pigeons per stage (total 45 clays per shooter). No limit on number of shots.

Ranger officer calls shooter to the line (one shooter at a time)

Shooter retrieves shotgun from rack (unloaded, action open) and steps into free fire zone

At range officer's instruction, shooter loads shotgun and makes ready

Shooter will call "Pull" at which time the thrower will release one clay

After 15 clays have been thrown shooter will unload and make clear

After range officer check, shooter will return shotgun to rack leaving action open

Stage Description:

Stage 1: 15 clay pigeons thrown straight (motors off)

Stage 2: 15 clay pigeons thrown with random elevation (elevation motor engaged)

Stage 3: 15 clay pigeons thrown with random elevation and direction (elevation and oscillating motors engaged)

Scoring:

Number of hits vs number of shots to determine hit percentage. No awards for ranking.
